BALMORHEA STATE PARK

9207 Texas 17, Toyahvale
It's the largest spring-fed pool in the world.

BARTON SPRINGS

2201 William Barton Dr, Austin
A year-round outdoor pool that is always 69 degrees.

BARTON CREEK GREENBELT

3755 S Capital of Texas Hwy, Austin
Swim at Sculpture Falls after hiking about a half-mile to Twin Falls for this great watering hole.

BLUE HOLE REGIONAL PARK

333 Bluehole Ln, Wimberley
The whole family will enjoy swimming in crystal clear water; sunbathing on the grassy swim lawn, and of course, swinging on our famous rope swings.

CAMPBELL'S HOLE BEACH

1337 Spyglass Dr, Austin
An out-of-the-way beach that is popular with locals who want to avoid the crowds.

CYPRESS FALLS

50 Marina Cr, Wimberley
Located on the largest portion of cypress creek. Wristbands required. Rentals available.

DEEP EDDY POOL

401 Deep Eddy Dr, Austin
The oldest pool in Texas, you can feel the history oozing out of it while swimming.

DEVIL'S WATERHOLE

3630 Road 4 West, Burnet
Scenic swimming spot dotted with waterfalls and filled with clear water.

DOUBLE LAKE RECREATION AREA

2221 N Raguet St, Lufkin
Located in the Sam Houston National Forest, it's a great place to swim and camp.

FRIO RIVER AT GARNER STATE PARK

234 RR 1050, Concan
Great spot to cool off in with lots of excellent views.

HAMILTON POOL

24300 Hamilton Rd, Dripping Springs
The watering hole, with some spectacular views, is covered by a half dome.

HUNTSVILLE STATE PARK

565 Park Rd 40 West, Huntsville
Swim, fish and paddle in Lake Raven while camping at Huntsville.

JACOBS WELL NATURAL AREA

1699 Mt. Sharp Rd, Wimberley
One of the longest underwater caves in Texas (check website for availability).

KRAUSE SPRINGS

404 Krause Springs Rd, Spicewood
A privately owned camping and swimming site, Krause Springs has 32 springs.

LAKE LIVINGSTON STATE PARK

300 State Rd 65, Livingston
One of the largest lakes in Texas, Lake Livingston has plenty of cool, deep water to splash around in.

LAKE LONGHORN MULTISPORT TRAINING LAKE

2391 Gun Range Rd, League City
A lake for serious athletes who like to scuba dive or swim competitively or for anyone who wants to just take a dip.

LAKE SOMERVILLE

14222 Park Rd 57, Somerville
Great place for kids to swim in this shallow water lake.

MARTIN DIES JR. STATE PARK

634 Park Rd 48, South Jasper
Swim in the B.A. Steinhagen Reservoir, or rent kayaks and canoes.

MCKINNEY FALLS STATE PARK

5808 McKinney Falls Pkwy, Austin
For sheer beauty, you can't beat Onion Creek for swimming with its limestone ledges and clear water.

MENARD CREEK

6439 Holly Grove Rd, Livingston
An out-of-the-way creek that is good for a summer splash.

RIO VISTA PARK

555 Cheatham St, San Marcos, TX
This section of the San Marcos River which is a constant 72 degrees is perfect for swimming and tubing or snorkeling and scuba diverting.

SCOTT'S RIDGE SWIM SITE

13274 Scotts Ridge Rd, Montgomery
Located on Lake Conroe, Scott's has picnic tables, a boat launch and a swimming hole.

THE QUINCE CAMP WOODS

300 W 7th St. Camp, Wood
A gorgeous swimming hole fed by the Nueces River that is secluded from the crowds.

WOLF CREEK PARK

21 Wolf Creek Park Rd., Coldspring
A great place for campers at Wolf Creek to swim at Lake Livingston, which is good for kids or experienced swimmers.

WOODSY HOLLOW CAMPGROUND

248 Woodsy Hollow Rd., Goodrich
Swim at Sleepy Hollow Lake, a beautiful private lake, while camping at Woodsy Hollow.
