

Bee Cave was a quiet enclave of Austin until 1987 when it was incorporated to avoid annexation. Its <u>history</u> dates back to the 1850s when residents found quiet spaces on the outskirts of bustling Austin.

Today, the City of Bee Cave holds a population of nearly 10,000 and attracts tourists as a destination for nature lovers, art enthusiasts, shoppers, and families. The city is separated into 12 neighborhoods within city limits, of which 11 have homeowner's associations. There are an additional two neighborhoods with HOAs just outside of the Bee Cave city limits.

Hill Country Galleria is the heart of Bee Cave, with more than 100 shops and restaurants, including a theater and Whole Foods Market. The space also hosts weekly and annual events like the Lone Star Farmers Market every Sunday, concerts, and an ice rink during the holiday season. Students living in Bee Cave can enroll in the Lake Travis Independent School District, which also encompasses residents of Rough Hollow, Lake Pointe, Lake Travis, Lakeway, Serene Hills, and West Cyprus Hills. Five elementary schools, two middle schools, and a high school serve the district. Families may also choose to send

their children to the <u>International School of Texas</u>, an International Baccalaureate school with a PreK-8 campus in Bee Cave.

Visitors to the area are encouraged to see <u>Star Hill Ranch</u>, a historical village of 22 buildings constructed in Texas between 1850 and 1935. These structures were then relocated to the ranch and restored to give guests a view of early Texas life. The ranch also hosts events — like weddings and festivals — and is a destination for film crews.


