<u>Hutto, Texas</u>, is located in Williamson County and is part of the Round Rock-Austin metropolitan area with a population of approximately 28,000.

Hutto is known as the <u>hippo capital of Texas</u>, as the hippo has been the official mascot of Hutto since 1923.

There are several folklore stories about how Hutto residents came to adopt the hippo as the town's mascot. Some stories link directly to the high school and its earliest football teams. A more fantastical origin story involves Hutto residents helping a circus troupe dislodge their hippo from Cottonwood Creek.

Regardless of how Hutto became the hippo capital of the Lone Star State, it is safe to say that residents have fully embraced this status. In total, more than 3,000 concrete hippos are dispersed throughout the city. These hippos are positioned in front of businesses, residents, and city buildings.

Hutto is also home to several great eateries. Shockingly, one of their most popular food options does not include the word "hippo" in its name. The restaurant, <u>baked'n sconed</u> does not even have a hippo-themed menu. What they do have are mouth-watering pastries, piping hot coffee, and delectable breakfast and lunch dishes.

Hutto also has several recreational options. One of the town's biggest draws is the <u>Star Ranch Golf Club</u>. This beautiful course offers prime views of the Texas landscape and a premium golfing experience.


