The earliest settlements in what is now Katy, Texas, began in 1872. Where there was once an open prairie, a town has flourished. Industries like rice and peanut farming took root, helping the city grow into the community that it is today.

Katy's history still remains visible throughout the city through landmarks like the historic homes of Heritage Park and the train station museum at MKT Railroad Depot. Residents continue to celebrate an annual Rice Harvest Festival, which began in 1978 as a way of recognizing rice as a core part of Katy's economy.

Katy serves as a three-county junction of Harris, Fort Bend and Waller counties and sits nearly 30 miles from downtown Houston. Today, Katy is a city of around 25,000 residents. Locals bask in the nature of city and county parks, like Katy City Park or the aquatic center at Mary Jo Peckham Park. Visitors flock to Katy each summer to enjoy the Texas Typhoon Water Park, which has water rides for all ages and a lazy river for families.

City events are held throughout the year and engage the community and its history. In addition, the Katy

Independent School District includes two major football stadiums: Katy Independent School District's Legacy Football Stadium, which seats 12,000 fans, and Katy Independent School District's Rhodes Stadium, which seats 9,700. The annual ISD Livestock Show and Rodeo supports agricultural education within the ISD.
