

<u>Kingwood</u>, sometimes known as the "Livable Forest," is a Houston <u>Super Neighborhood</u> on the northeast side of the city. Kingwood began as a master-planned community created by the Friendswood Development Company in 1971, then was officially annexed by the city of Houston in 1996.

Residents live in one of more than 30 named neighborhoods or villages within Kingwood, each of which has its own playground for village residents. Today, Kingwood is known for its abundance of nature even amongst a growing city.

A crowning feature that residents of Kingwood can enjoy is its "greenbelt," a natural area that runs for over 75 miles throughout the community. In addition to enjoying its inherent beauty, trails in the greenbelt also benefit community members by providing a safe way to walk to nearby schools, parks, and other locations.

While Kingwood's status as a haven for natural beauty makes it an excellent place for walking, fishing, and other outdoor activities, its relative proximity to downtown makes it just as easy to participate in the excitement of a major metropolitan area.


